

**DIRECTIVE 11/2020**  
**UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204**

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 7 April 2020,
  - 1.1. Foreigners arriving in Brunei Darussalam are required to comply to current requirements i.e. undergo mandatory 14-days self-isolation at a government-designated accommodation and they are also required to bear the full cost of the self-isolation.
2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
