

DIRECTIVE 16/2020

UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 22 May 2020,
 - 1.1. Anyone registered as “runners” with the Government are required to comply with guidelines for runners which has been issued by the Government, especially when handling goods such as wearing face masks, gloves, Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) i.e. apron, raincoat or *poncho*. Legal actions may be taken on anyone who fails to comply with the guidelines and their permit revoked.
2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
