

DIRECTIVE 5/2020

UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 15 March 2020,
 - 1.1. Bruneian participants to the *Pontianak Bike Week*, held from 12 to 14 March 2020 in Kalimantan, Indonesia and *Borneo Ultra Trail Marathon 2020*, held from 14 to 16 March 2020 in Sabah, Malaysia are required to register with Port Health Unit at all points of entry, including Brunei Internasional Airport upon return to this country to receive the 14-days self-isolation guidelines. Those who have not registered are required to contact Health Advice Line 148.
 - 1.2. **From 16 March 2020, all citizens and residents of Brunei Darussalam are prohibited from leaving the country,** except in certain situations such as receiving urgent medical treatment, attending a court hearing or proceeding with an educational session overseas, depending on the approval by the Prime Minister's Office. Applications may be submitted through e-mail to travelapplication@jpm.gov.bn, with scanned copied of supportive documents attached.

2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
