

**OFFENCES UNDER
INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204**

Section 71 under the Infectious Diseases Act Chapter 204 provides for the Director-General of Health Services to compound offences under the Act: *“The Director-General may compound any offence under this Act or any regulations made thereunder by accepting from the person reasonably suspected of having committed that offence a sum not exceeding \$5,000.”*

Compound rates for offences under the Infectious Diseases Act Chapter 204 as follows,
