2. The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public that individuals who would like to take the SARS-CoV-2 swab test, especially for the purpose of travelling abroad must take the swab test **3 – 5 days (three to five days) before their flight date – subject to**

**the terms and conditions of the country to which it is intended.** The results of the swab test will take time and the Ministry seeks the public’s patience while waiting for their test results.

- Individuals who are taking the SARS-CoV-2 swab test for the purpose of travelling abroad can take the swab test at the location and time specified below:
