

DIRECTIVE 6/2020

UNDER SECTION 62A INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT CHAPTER 204

1. Under the Infectious Diseases Act (Amendments) Order 2020 which took effect from 30 January 2020 and Ministry of Health media statement on 17 March 2020,
 - 1.1. Brunei Darussalam is maintaining entry prohibition for visitors arriving from Hubei province, People's Republic of China and Islamic Republic of, and extending it to Europe and United Kingdom. This prohibition applies to those who have been in the said countries within 14 days before arriving in this country and is exempted for citizens and residents of Brunei Darussalam.
 - 1.2. Anyone arriving from any country is required to undergo 14-days self-isolation upon arrival in Brunei Darussalam.
 - 1.3. Risk categorization for affected countries is no longer in use.
2. Failure to comply with this directive is an offence under the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and if found guilty, will be liable to a fine for up to \$10,000 or imprisonment for a period of up to 6 months or both.
