1. The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public on the current situation of the COVID-19 infection in Brunei Darussalam for Friday, 22 Jamadilakhir 1442 / 05 February 2021, as of 12.00 noon.

2. Case 181 is a man aged 36 years old that arrived in this country from Europe via Kuala Lumpur on 22 January 2021 on board flight Royal Brunei BI874. The contact tracing for this case has found that no one is categorized as a close contact as he has been quarantined upon arrival in the country and his entire travel arrangements upon arrival and isolation have been in accordance with existing operating procedures (SOP).
3. Meanwhile, one case that was treated at the National Isolation Centre has recovered, bringing the total number of recovered cases to 173 cases.
4. With this latest development, a total of 5 active cases are being treated at the National Isolation Center and all of them are in a stable condition.
