



MEDIA STATEMENT OF THE CURRENT SITUATION OF THE COVID-19 INFECTION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

02 Syawal 1441 / 25 May 2020

1. The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public that today, Monday, 02 Syawal 1441 / 25 May 2020, Alhamdulillah with the grace of Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'Ala, **there is no new case** of COVID-19 infection in the country. Therefore, **the total number of COVID-19 cases in Brunei Darussalam remains at 141 cases.**
2. Meanwhile, there is **no case** that has recovered from COVID-19 today, therefore **the total number of cases recovered remains at 137 individuals.** This brings the number of active cases still being treated at the National Isolation Center to **3 cases**, where 2 are still in critical condition. However, only one of them still require heart / lung machine (ECMO) as well as respiratory assistance, and one case only requires respiratory assistance. Meanwhile, the rest are in a stable condition.

3. In the past 24 hours, a total of **55 samples** have been tested for the SARS-CoV2 virus, that brings the total number of laboratory tests conducted since January 2020 to **18,589 tests**.

4. Furthermore, following the announcement on the ***Bruhealth App***, Alhamdulillah at this time a total of **207,395 individuals** have registered as users to the application. In addition to that, a total of **3,386 businesses and premises** have registered for the application. With that, members of the public who have not registered are encouraged to download and register to the Bruhealth App. Public cooperation in the use of the Bruhealth app as well as scanning QR codes in and out of premises is necessary as it will ensure the safety of the public including the employees and customers, as well as facilitate the Ministry of Health to make contact tracing in case an outbreak of infection occurs.
