InPatient Wards

Go-live on 31st January 2013

Following the Wave 1 (Pre-registration) roll out since 18th December 2012, the various Inpatient Wards has gone live in stages since 31st January 2013. The Patient Admission is done mainly by the Medical Record Department (MRD) in which SSBH has setup an Admission Center (AC) to handle all patient admissions including patient registrations, admission, collection of any fees/deposits and beds assignments.

Other supporting ancillary services such as Pharmacy, Radiology , Lab, Store & Billing has also gone live.

Clinicians have been using the system to review Patient’s medical records including clinical notes and also entering of on-going diagnosis & clinical notes in addition to placing orders for laboratory, radiology and pharmacy via the system. IP nurses are using the system too for entering of patient’s vital signs and entering of progress notes as well.



Suri Seri Begawan Hospital (SSBH) UAT with Users on 22nd, 3rd January 2013 and 20th, 21st February 2013

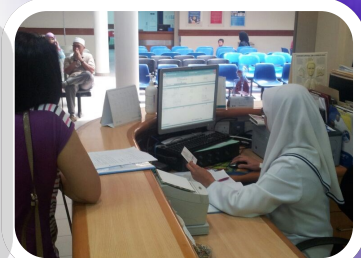


As part of the pre-roll out activities, the User Acceptance Tests (UAT) was also conducted jointly between the SSBH Core Team and the Project Team. This was mainly done to for the users to familiarize with the system usage and also verify that the core functions of the system is working appropriately.

22nd & 23rd January 2013 : IP Admission & Outpatient Clinic UAT scenarios were conducted and the outcome was positive with feedbacks from users gathered.

20th & 21st February 2013 : Accident & Emergency and Materials Management UAT scenarios were conducted and the outcome was positive with feedbacks from users gathered.

Suri Seri Begawan Hospital (SSBH) OutPatient Clinics Go-live on 2nd March 2013



Together with Accident & Emergency (A&E), the various Outpatient Clinics has gone live in stages since 2nd March 2013 where all patients will register their visits at the Central Registration Counters (manned by the Medical Record Department-MRD) before proceeding to the respective Clinics. Patients will make payment first at the Finance counter, get a receipt/coupon, then proceed to MRD to register visit by showing the coupon.

Clinicians are now using the system to review Patient's medical records and also entering of on-going diagnosis & clinical notes in addition to placing orders for laboratory, radiology and pharmacy via the system.



Ripas Hospital, Pre-registration Go-Live on 11th March 2013

RIPAS Hospital experienced its Phase -1 go-live of Pre-registration on 11th march 8:00 AM onwards where in 9 patient registration locations were commissioned to register Patients. First 2 days was dedicated to registration of all RIPASH staff at Specialist Building 2, after which the registration was opened to Public from 13th March onwards where Honourable Minister of Health Pehin Orang Kaya Johan Pahlawan Dato Seri Setia Awang Haji Adanan bin Begawan Pehin Siraja Khatib Dato Seri Setia Awang Haji Mohd Yusof, came in to grace the occasion and experience the go-live activities along with the Hospital team. He registered himself in Bru-HIMS. Within a week's time around 1500 people were registered and received their Bru-HIMS Id's.

Ripas Hospital, State Store Go-Live on 18th March 2013



State Medical Store experienced the Phase – 2 go live on 18th March 8:00 AM onwards where the SMS team started entering data in Bru-HIMS for opening stock counting. This activity continued until 24th March after which the live transactions of stock request and acknowledgement was carried out from different health facilities. With this initiative now all remote sites and health facilities can order stock online and also be able to received and update status online.

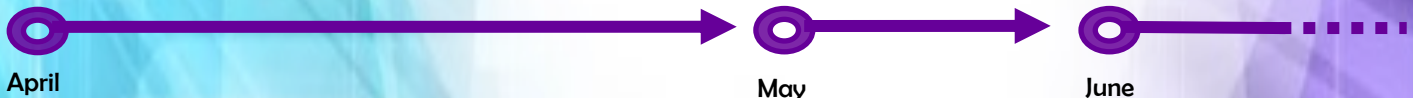
