Interactions	How compatible is your drug if taken with other medicines or food?
Precautions	What you should know before taking your medicine?
Health and Lifestyle Advice	What changes do you need to make when taking your medicine?



Speak to your pharmacist when in doubt of your medicines:

- ◆ **What your medicines used for?**
- ◆ **You need more information or clarification about your medicines.**
- ◆ **You have been prescribed a new medicine or medicinal device by your doctor.**
- ◆ **Your medicine and dosage have been changed by your doctor.**
- ◆ **You are experiencing undesirable effects with your medicine.**
- ◆ **You are taking other medicines such as over-the-counter medicines, traditional or herbal medicines.**
- ◆ **You intend to get pregnant, already expecting or breastfeeding.**
- ◆ **You are taking health supplements.**
- ◆ **You are planning to travel.**
