

HEALTH PROTOCOL IF YOU ARE CONFIRMED POSITIVE WITH COVID-19

PROTOCOL 1

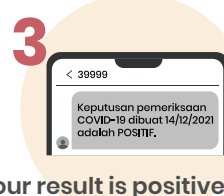
Received a referral from a doctor to undergo a PCR test



1 Get a PCR swab test.



2 Self-isolate immediately from household members and others while awaiting for the PCR result.



3 If your result is positive or your BruHealth code turns purple, wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from tTalian Darussalam (TD) 123 for further management.

PROTOCOL 2

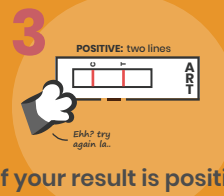
If you have flu-like symptoms



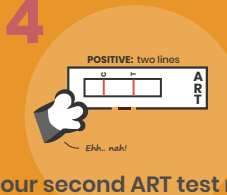
1 Self-isolate immediately from household members and others.



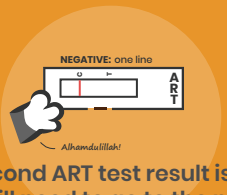
2 Perform an ART test using your own ART kit.



3 If your result is positive, repeat the second ART test within 24-hours.



4 If your second ART test result is positive, this means you are confirmed **positive** for COVID-19. Report your ART test via www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport or call TD 123. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management.



If your second ART test result is **negative**, you will need to go to the nearest swab centre (within 24-hours) for a PCR test, and then self-isolate at home. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management. If your PCR test result is negative, you will be notified via SMS. Make sure your number is updated in your Bru-HIMS account.



5 During the call from TD 123, you will be assigned with an infection category

Category 1 and Category 2A	Category 2B until Category 5
<p>continue self-isolation at home and will be contacted by TD 123 throughout the period of isolation until discharge.</p>	<p>will receive a call from TD 123 to be transferred to a COVID-19 Isolation Centre.</p>

PROTOCOL 3

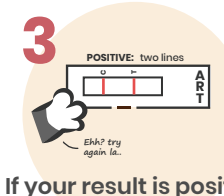
No symptoms but tested positive on ART test



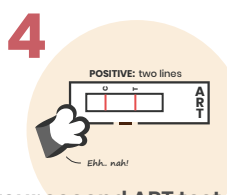
1 Self-isolate immediately from household members and others.



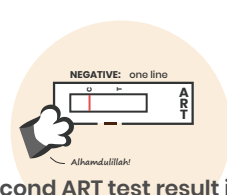
2 Perform an ART test using your own ART kit.



3 If your result is positive, repeat the second ART test within 24-hours.



4 If your second ART test result is positive, this means you are confirmed **positive** for COVID-19. Report your ART test via www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport or call TD 123. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management.



If your second ART test result is **negative**, you will need to go to the nearest swab centre (within 24-hours) for a PCR test, and then self-isolate at home. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management. If your PCR test result is negative, you will be notified via SMS. Make sure your number is updated in your Bru-HIMS account.



5 During the call from TD 123, you will be assigned with an infection category

Category 1 and Category 2A	Category 2B until Category 5
<p>continue self-isolation at home and will be contacted by TD 123 throughout the period of isolation until discharge.</p>	<p>will receive a call from TD 123 to be transferred to a COVID-19 Isolation Centre.</p>

PROTOCOL 4

Identified as a close contact of a positive case



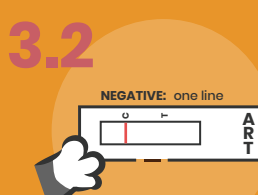
1 You will receive a call from TD 123. Self-isolate immediately from household members and others.



2 Perform an ART test on the first day using your own ART or call TD 123 if you don't have an ART kit.

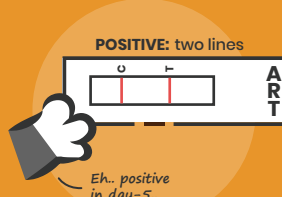


3.1 If your result is **positive**, this means you are confirmed positive for COVID-19. Report your ART test via www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport or call TD 123. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management.



If your ART result is **negative**:

SCENARIO 1: have not had any symptoms for 5 days of self-isolation	SCENARIO 2: you develop symptoms during your 5 days self-isolation period
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue self-isolation for 5 days. Perform ART test on Day-5 and upload the test results of the Day-1 and Day-5 at www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport. If you need any assistance, call TD 123. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Perform ART testing immediately. If your result is positive, this means you are confirmed positive for COVID-19. Report your ART test via www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport or call TD 123. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management. If your ART test result is negative, you will need to continue self-isolation until Day-5. Perform ART test on Day-5 and upload the test results of the Day-1 and Day-5 at www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport. If you need any assistance, call TD 123.



Eh... positive in day-5.

POSITIVE ART TEST ON DAY-5

This means you have tested positive for COVID-19. Report your ART test via www.moh.gov.bn/ARTReport or call TD 123. Wait for an SMS from the Ministry of Health and then a call from TD 123 for further management.
