2. Case 176 is a woman aged 23 years old who arrived in Brunei Darussalam on BI874 flight on 13 January 2021 from Nepal via Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. She is currently being monitored and treated at the National Isolation Centre. The contact tracing for this case has found that she does not have any close contacts.
3. Currently, a total of 4 active cases are being treated at the National Isolation Centre, where all the patients are in stable condition.
