



## MEDIA STATEMENT OF THE CURRENT SITUATION OF THE COVID-19 INFECTION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

## 15 Syawal 1441 / 07 June 2020

- 1. The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public that today, Saturday, 15 Syawal 1441 / 07 June 2020, Alhamdulillah with the grace of Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'Ala, there is no new case of COVID-19 infection in the country. Therefore, the total number of COVID-19 cases in Brunei Darussalam remains at 141 cases, whereas the total number of cases that have recovered is 138 individuals.
- 2. At this time, there is only **one case** still being treated at the National Isolation Centre, where the case is still in critical condition and require heart / lung machine (ECMO) as well as respiratory assistance. Let us together pray for the patient to be granted full recovery by Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'ala. Aamiin Ya Rabbal Alamiin
- 3. In the past 24 hours, a total of **502 samples** have been tested for the SARS-CoV2 virus, that brings the total number of laboratory

tests conducted since January 2020 to **21,659 tests**. In this regard, the Ministry of Health would like to share the statistics of the surveillance conducted in the third week of de-escalation, that is from I until 5 June 2020 as follows:

- a. 426 samples taken on foreign workers surveillance;
- b. 489 samples taken on community surveillance; and
- c. 481 samples taken for expanded surveillance such as on frontliners and staff working at child care centres, preschools, and elderly care centres.
- 4. Following the announcement on the **Bruhealth App**, Alhamdulillah at this time a total of **281,969 individuals** have registered as users to the application. In addition to that, a total of **6,034 businesses** and premises have registered for the application.
