

MEDIA STATEMENT OF THE CURRENT SITUATION OF THE COVID-19 INFECTION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

17 Syawal 1441 / 09 June 2020

- The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public that today, Tuesday, 17 Syawal 1441 / 09 June 2020, Alhamdulillah with the grace of Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'Ala, there is no new case of COVID-19 infection in the country. Therefore, the total number of COVID-19 cases in Brunei Darussalam remains at 141 cases, whereas the total number of cases that have recovered is 138 individuals.
- 2. At this time, there is only **one case** still being treated at the National Isolation Centre, where the case is still in critical condition and require heart / lung machine (ECMO) as well as respiratory assistance. Let us together pray for the patient to be granted full recovery by Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'ala. Aamiin Aamiin Ya Rabbal Alamin.

- 3. At this time, **120 individuals** are currently undergoing quarantine in accordance to the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and a total of **2,703 individuals** have completed their quarantine and are in good condition.
- 4. In the past 24 hours, a total of **572 samples** have been tested for the SARS-CoV-2 virus that brings the total number of laboratory tests conducted since January 2020 to **22,664 tests**. In relation to the contacts of the cases found to be positive in Kuala Lumpur, laboratory tests for the SARS-CoV-2 virus on 134 contacts of the cases are found to be negative, while others are still pending test results.
- 5. Following the announcement on the **Bruhealth App**, Alhamdulillah at this time a total of **287,799 individuals** have downloaded the application in their respective phones and a total of **355,402** members have registered to the application. In addition to that, a total of **6,212 companies and premises** have registered for the BruHealth application. Meanwhile, a total of 1,778 business premises have downloaded the PremisScan application, which is intended for the use of individuals who do not have access to mobile phone devices to enter these premises.
