

MEDIA STATEMENT OF THE CURRENT SITUATION OF THE COVID-19 INFECTION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

18 Syawal 1441 / 10 June 2020

- The Ministry of Health would like to inform the public that today, Wednesday, 18 Syawal 1441 / 10 June 2020, Alhamdulillah with the grace of Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'Ala, there is no new case of COVID-19 infection in the country. Therefore, the total number of COVID-19 cases in Brunei Darussalam remains at 141 cases, whereas the total number of cases that have recovered is 138 individuals.
- 2. At this time, there is only **one case** still being treated at the National Isolation Centre, where the case is still in critical condition and require heart / lung machine (ECMO) as well as respiratory assistance. Let us together pray for the patient to be granted full recovery by Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'ala. Aamiin Aamiin Ya Rabbal Alamin.

- 3. At this time, **120 individuals** are currently undergoing quarantine in accordance to the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and a total of **2,703 individuals** have completed their quarantine and are in good condition.
- 4. In the past 24 hours, a total of 625 samples have been tested for the SARS-CoV-2 virus that brings the total number of laboratory tests conducted since January 2020 to 23,293 tests. Alhamdulillah, in relation to the contacts of the cases found to be positive in Kuala Lumpur, laboratory tests for the SARS-CoV-2 virus on all the contacts of the cases are found to be negative.
- 5. Following the announcement on the **Bruhealth App**, Alhamdulillah at this time a total of **365,604 individuals** have registered to the application. In addition to that, a total of **6,828 companies and premises** have registered for the BruHealth application. Meanwhile, a total of 1,902 business premises have downloaded the PremiseScan application, which is intended for the use of individuals who do not have access to mobile phone devices to enter these premises.
- 6. Furthermore, in relation to bookings to perform Friday Prayer, the Ministry of Health would like to remind any jamaah who is still not ready and have concerns to perform the Friday Prayer at the

mosque to not make any bookings in the BruHealth system. However, for those jamaah who have booked but at the last moment feels unwell, are advised to click on the "I am not going" button in the BruHealth system. This takes into account the filling of the slots in the selected mosques, musalla and surau, and hinders other jamaah from making their bookings. Therefore, by not booking the slot or by clicking the "I am not going" button, it will release the slot and consequently will allow other jamaah who wishes to really attend to get a slot to perform their Friday Prayer.
