



## MEDIA STATEMENT OF THE CURRENT SITUATION OF THE COVID-19 INFECTION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

## 15 April 2020

- 1. The Ministry of Health would like to announce that today, Wednesday, 21 Syaaban 1441 / 15 April 2020, Alhamdulillah, by the grace of Allah Subhanahu Wa Ta'ala, there is no new case of COVID-19 infection in the country. Therefore, the total number of COVID-19 cases in Brunei Darussalam remains at 136 cases.
- 2. Meanwhile, **1 case** have recovered and allowed to return home today from the National Isolation Center. Therefore, the total number of cases recovered remains at **108 cases**.
- 3. At this time, the total number of active cases still being treated at the National Isolation Center remains at **27 cases**, where 2 are still in critical condition and both require heart / lung machine (ECMO) and respiratory assistance. Meanwhile, the rest are in a stable condition.
- 4. At this time as well, **81 individuals** are currently undergoing quarantine in accordance to the Infectious Diseases Act (Chapter 204) and a total of **2,394 individuals** have completed their quarantine

5. In the past 24 hours, a total of 229 samples have been tested for the

SARS-CoV-2 virus, that brings the total number of laboratory tests

conducted since January 2020 to 10,579 tests, which brings a ratio of 1

in 41 people has undergone a COVID-19 test.

6. The Ministry of Health is pleased to announce that Alhamdulillah, one of

the cases that had been cured but was re-admitted to the National

Isolation Center after being positive after a follow-up examination, was

allowed to return home today. This is because a follow-up laboratory test

conducted at the National Isolation Center found that the case was

negative for SARS-CoV-2 virus. However, as a precautionary measure,

the case will undergo self-isolation for another 14 days at home.
